5. Medical forms will be due, along with camp tuition of \$175 by May 15th, 2009 to hold a spot at camp.

4. Have you participated in activities at school or home that conserve natural resources or demonstrate your interest in learning more about forestry and wildlife? Explain.
5. Do you think that natural resources will last forever?
6. Why is it important to have clean water?
7. Why is it important to have clean air?
8. What are you interested in doing as a career? Why?
9. Why is it important to have trees and forests on your property or in your community?
10. To the best of your ability define "Working Forests".

The information and answered questions should be sent along with a letter of reference from a teacher, counselor, principal, or club/youth leader that has personal knowledge of your interests and conduct.
