



Application for Extreme Exemption
While Under a Governor's Ban on Outdoor Burning
Form AG-2018-02

The purpose of this form is to allow individuals to burn due to extreme hardship while their county is under the Governor's Ban on Outdoor Burning dated April 26, 2018. The State recognizes the economic importance of controlled burning as a valuable management tool. Applicants must also recognize the severe drought conditions that necessitate the burning ban, their legal liabilities when conducting controlled burning and the need to take extra precautions when conducting such burning.

Upon approval by the State Forester, a letter for Extreme Exemption from the burn ban will be delivered to the applicant. Completed forms must be Faxed or mailed to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, 2800 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, OK 73105, FAX 405-522-4583.

NO EXEMPTIONS WILL BE GRANTED FOR CAMP FIRES, NORMAL BURNING OF BRUSH PILES, ACCUMULATION OF LEAVES IN YARDS OR BRUSH PILES IN YARDS, OR HOUSEHOLD TRASH.
