



Outdoor Burning Banned

Effective **February 23, 2018** by order of the Oklahoma Governor's Office, all outdoor burning, combustible materials and ignition sources are banned in the following Counties:

Beaver, Beckham, Cimarron, Custer, Dewey, Ellis, Greer, Harmon, Harper, Jackson, Kiowa, Roger Mills, Texas, Washita, Woods and Woodward counties.

Extreme fire conditions exist in these counties due to extraordinary drought. All conditions and exemptions are outlined by Oklahoma Forestry Services, a division of the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry, on its website:

Failure to observe this ban may result in criminal prosecution under O.S. Title 2 Article 16 § 26, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$1000, imprisonment for not more than one year, or both.
