Artist must reside in Arkansas, Louisiana, Texas or Oklahoma.

Entries submitted for competition must be an **original work** completed within the past eighteen months.

Entry Fees

\$ 10.00 per entry for Professional, Non-Professional

\$ 2.00 per entry for Students.

Rules

Commission of 20% will be levied for all sales.

Entry Forms **MUST** be Complete!

Indicate category (Professional, Non-Professional or Student), Sale price or NFS (Not for Sale), etc.

Art work **MUST** be ready to hang:
(NO sawtooth hangers or taped cords)

Canvas shall not exceed 4' x 6' or 24 square foot total.

Not eligible for judging: Giclee and other mechanically produced prints; works painted from copyrighted photographs, other paintings, or classes and workshops where everyone paints from the same composition.

Artists are responsible for checking work in and out at the appointed time. **No shipping of art.** Students work may be entered by the student or the teacher.

All artwork must remain until end of show.

Persons entering work in the Non-Professional division may not enter into the Professional division, and the reverse is also true.

Hanging of the artwork will be at the discretion of the art show committee.


